

## (DSV) Deep litter rake

The deep litter rake is designed to push the top of litter under the box in the bedding of the cow. Hereby the lounge is smooth and softer, and the litter dries better thus reducing the risk of diseases. To scrape the litter back in the lounge, topping up is less needed to still keep sufficient litter in the box, resulting in litter savings.

- Designed to work with a mini shovel and scrape litter as a solid fraction, compost, chopped straw or sand surfaces in a floating box.
- The deep litter rake is usable to the left and the right side with one doubleacting control valve, the rake is locked in the folded position and in working position and can be used pushing and pulling.
- Tilting is the tipping function of the shovel.
- There is also an option to mount a scraper to clean the grids or waiting room.
- While moving the rake can be adjusted in height and the slide continues to follow the ground.
- Width folded 1260mm, working width 2500mm from the centre shovel, in the box 1.500mm.
- Width vehicle max. 1.600mm
- Weight 230 kg.

## (DSVZ) Deep litter rake heavy

The DSVZ is designed for larger shovels, tractors, and telehandlers. This one has a heavier construction and the base is wider so that a wider vehicle can be linked.

- Width of vehicle max. 2400 mm.
- The rake part in the box is 1500 mm.
- Working width 2950mm from the centre shovel
- Weight 325 KG.
